ABSTRACT

In the summer and fall of 1980 a survey was conducted of the primary wood-using industries in Saskatchewan, including sawmills, planing mills, wood treating plants, and pulp, waferboard and plywood mills. Information was collected on mill location, ownership, capacity, wood supply, current production and employment, products, markets, marketing agents, woodlands equipment, mill facilities, and limiting factors for operation and expansion.

RESUME

A l'été et à l'automne 1980, une enquête a été menée sur les industries primaires du bois en Saskatchewan, y compris les scieries et les usines de rabotage, de traitement du bois, de pâtes, de panneaux gaufrés et de contreplaqué. Des données ont été colligées sur l'emplacement des usines, leur propriétaires, leur capacité, approvisionnement en bois, production et l'embauche actuelles, leurs produits, marchés, agents de commercialisation, leur équipement forestier, leurs installations ainsi que les facteurs limitatifs de leur exploitation et de leur expansion.

INTRODUCTION

Most of the information in this directory was collected during the summer and fall of 1980 by staff of the Northern Forest Research Centre through interviews with personnel of Saskatchewan's primary wood-using industries. The data collected in this survey covers one complete year of operation for each company; however, the time period varies between companies (e.g., fiscal vs. calendar year) because of individual operating and accounting procedures. In every instance the basis of the survey is a 12-month period beginning in 1979 and ending in 1980.

In this directory, Saskatchewan's primary wood-using industries are grouped into five activity categories: (1) sawmill-planing complexes, (2) independent planing mills, (3) wood treating plants, (4) miscellaneous wood-using industries (including building timber plants, lath mills, pallet plants, and post operations), and (5) pulp, waferboard, and plywood mills. Also provided are the names of known idle (but potentially productive) sawmills in 1979-80.

Sawmill-planing complexes have been grouped by output into four classes: (1) more than 5 MM fbm, (2) 1 MM to 4.999 MM fbm, (3) 100 M to 999 M fbm, and (4) less than 100 M fbm per year. There has been no attempt to separately describe sawmills and planing mills that function as integrated operations; however, planing mills that operate independently are listed in a separate category.

Information on mill location, ownership, capacity, wood supply, current production and employment, products, markets, marketing agents, woodlands equipment, and mill facilities is provided for each of Saskatchewan's primary wood-using industries. Highlights for 1979-80 include the production of approximately 218 MM fbm of lumber and 107 M bone dry units (2400 lb) of

wood chips by the sawmill industry and 4.3 MM cu ft by the wood treating industry (Table 1). The independent planing mills planed an additional 13 MM fbm, most of which was rough lumber produced by the sawmill industry. Approximately 300 M tons of pulp, 910 MM sq ft (1/16" basis) of waferboard, and 420 MM sq ft (1/16" basis) of plywood were also produced. Saskatchewan's 316 primary wood-using industries and independent log producers created 3623 man-years of employment.

For the convenience of the reader, a list of the abbreviations and definitions used throughout the directory appears on page 8, and an alphabetical index of the primary wood-using industries is provided on page 9. There are also listings of headquarters (Table 2) and regional (Table 3) personnel of the Forestry Branch, Saskatchewan Department of Tourism and Renewable Resources, and personnel of the Department of Northern Saskatchewan (Table 3), associations relevant to Saskatchewan's primary wood-using industries (Appendix 1), metric (SI) equivalents and conversion factors (Appendix 2), and selected conversion factors for timber products (Appendix 3).

SASKATCHEWAN'S TIMBER ALLOCATION SYSTEM

The province of Saskatchewan has four basic methods for allocating timber to the producers:

1. Forest management license agreement - negotiated agreement with a larger individual forest industry company, with term of operation longer than one year.
2. Timber permit - means of allocating timber to a wide range of different forest industry operations for a period of one year.
3. Forest product field permit - principal means of allocating small volumes of timber to individuals, essentially for their own use.
4. Term cutting agreement - guarantees a timber permit over a specified number of years (up to 10) under negotiated conditions.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

Bull rails - 2-4" thick planks with uneven barked edges obtained by cutting slabs from round logs; primarily used for heavy corral construction.

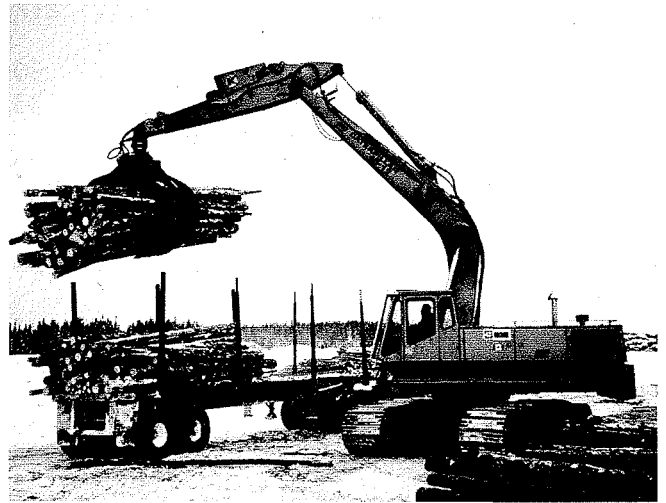

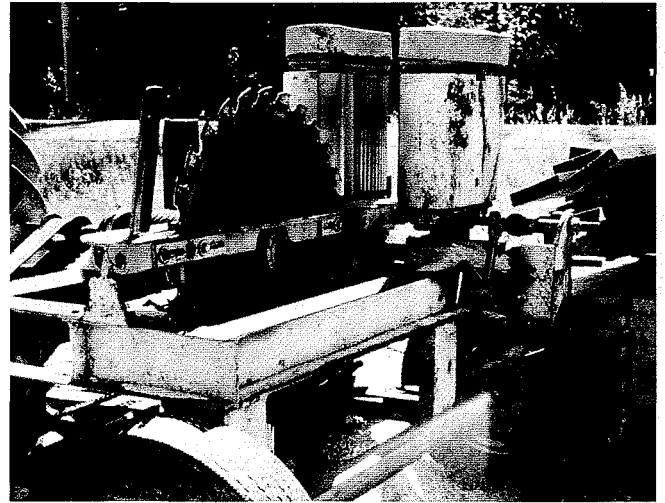

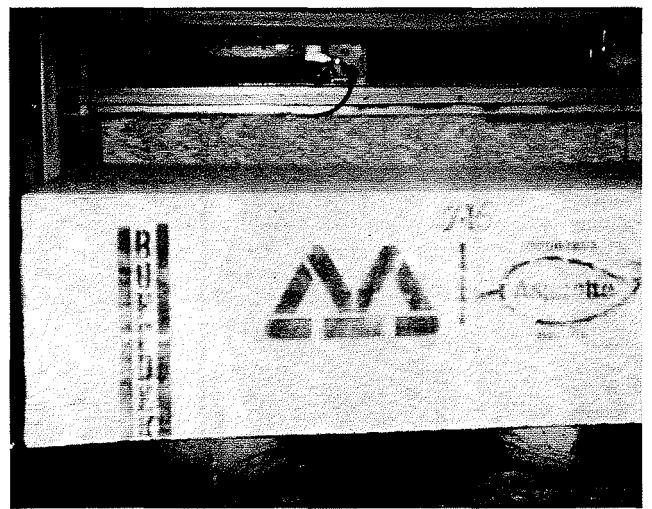

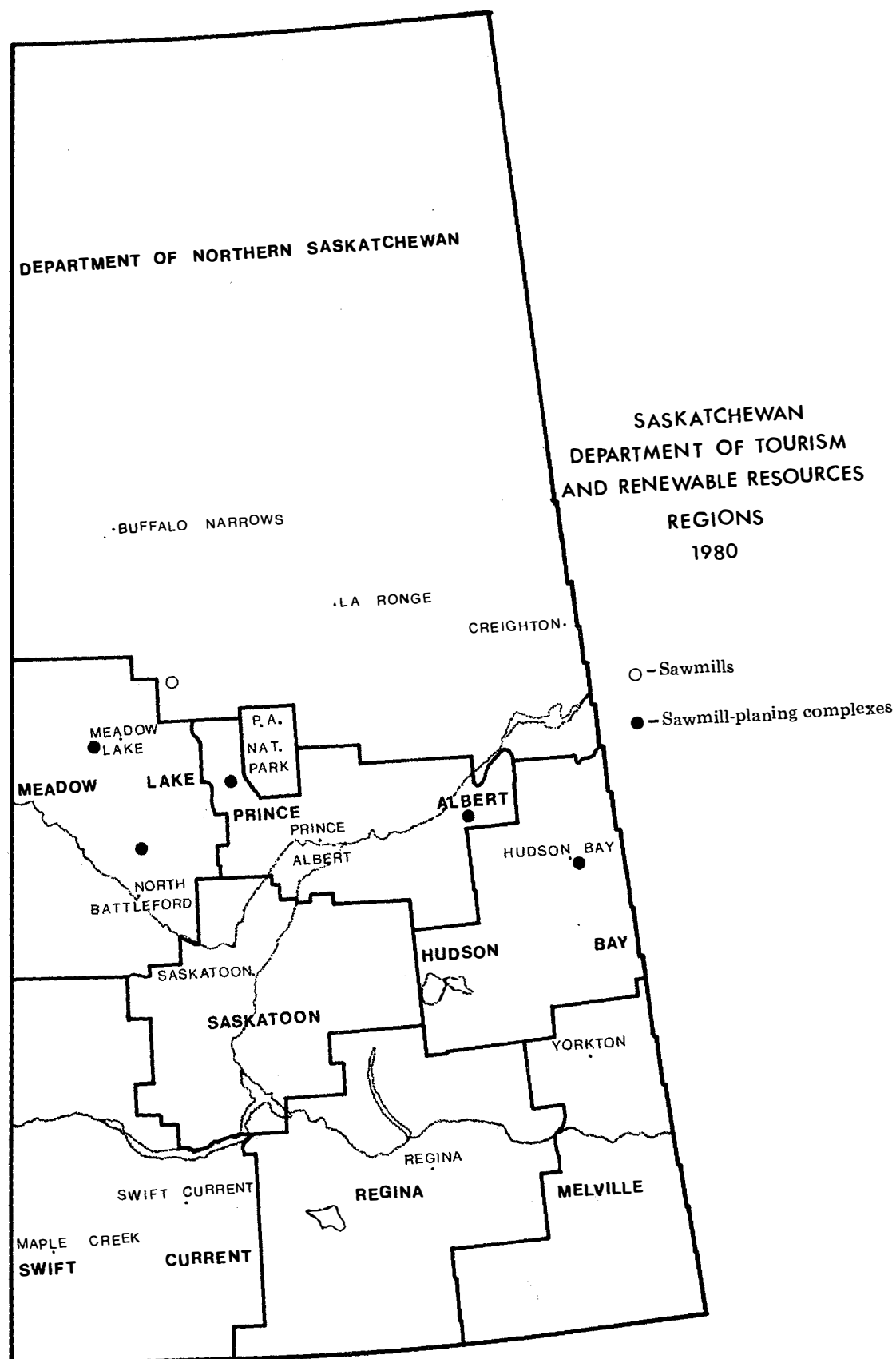


Figure 1. Location of sawmills producing more than 5 MM fbm per year.

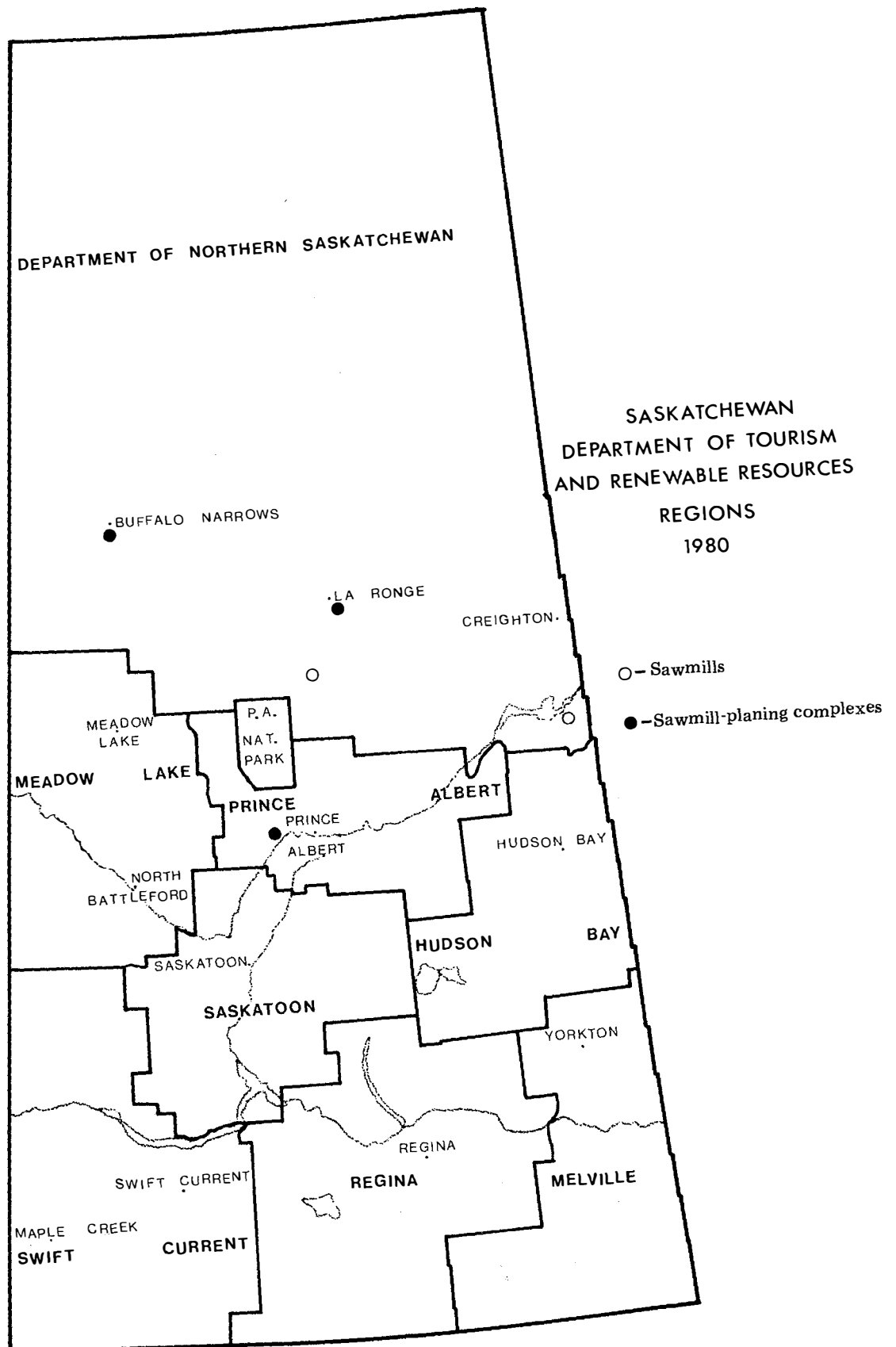


Figure 2. Location of sawmills producing 1 MM to 4.99 MM fbm per year.

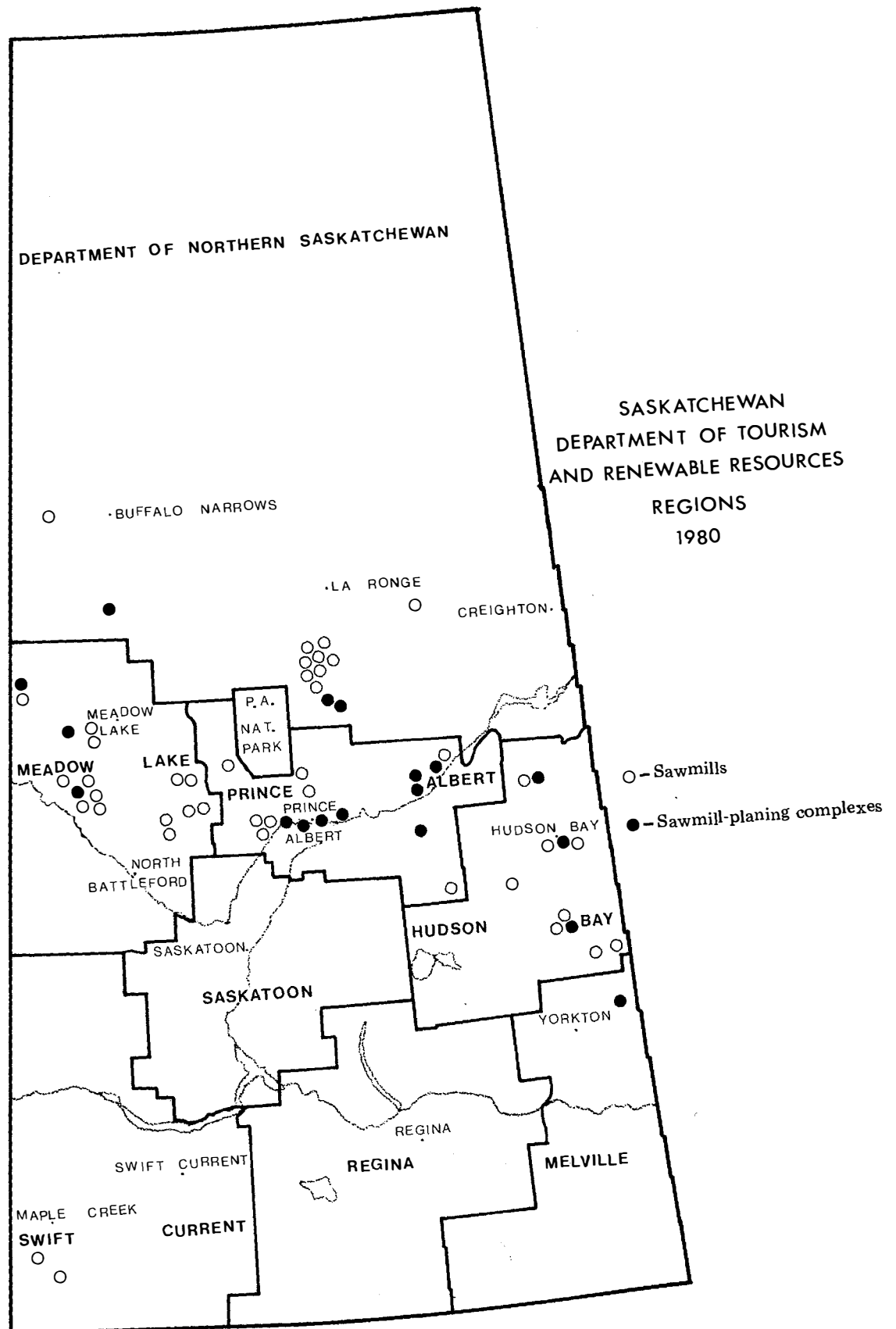


Figure 3. Location of sawmills producing 100 M to 999 M fbm per year.

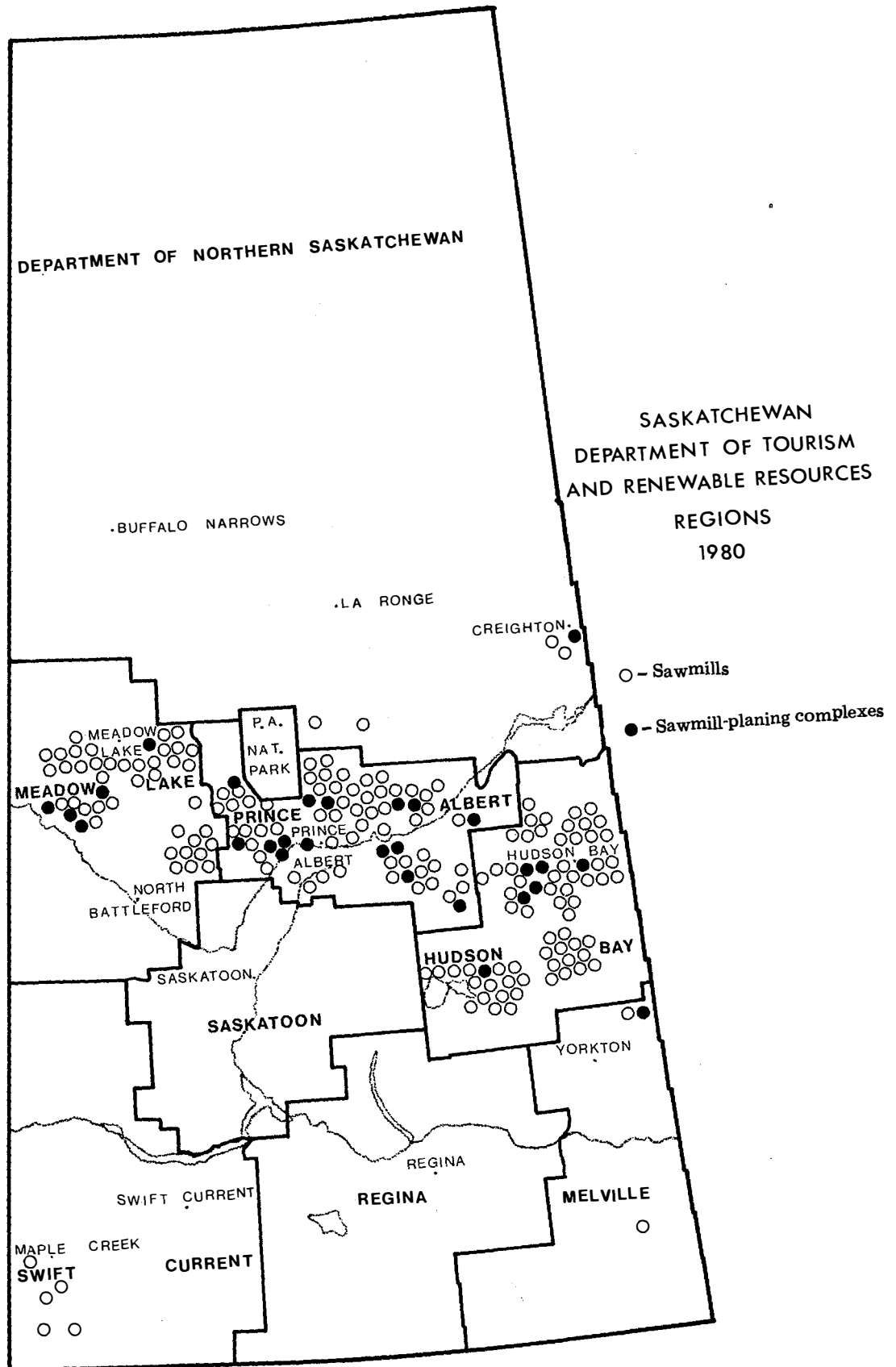


Figure 4. Location of sawmills producing less than 100 M fbm per year.

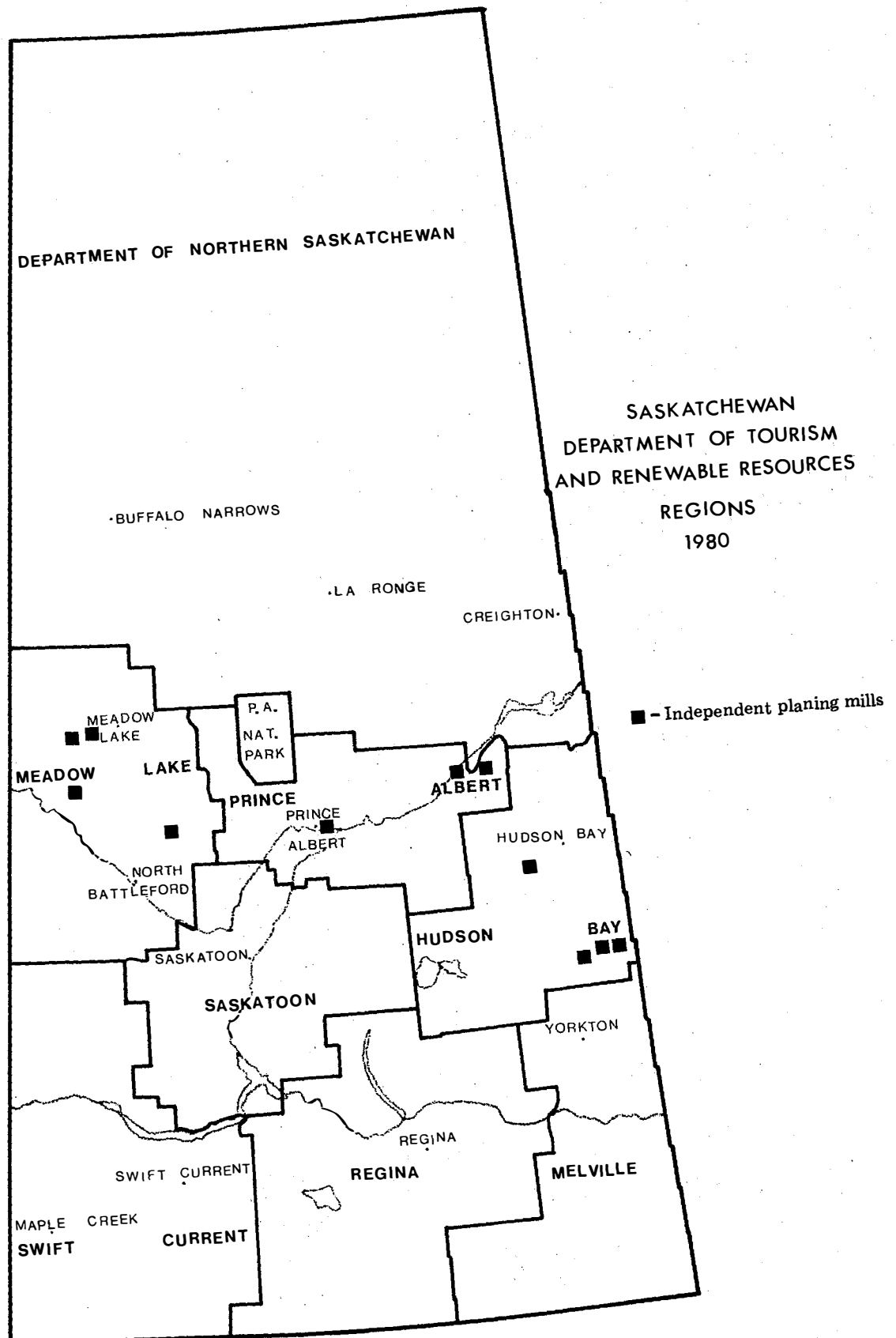


Figure 5. Location of independent planing mills.

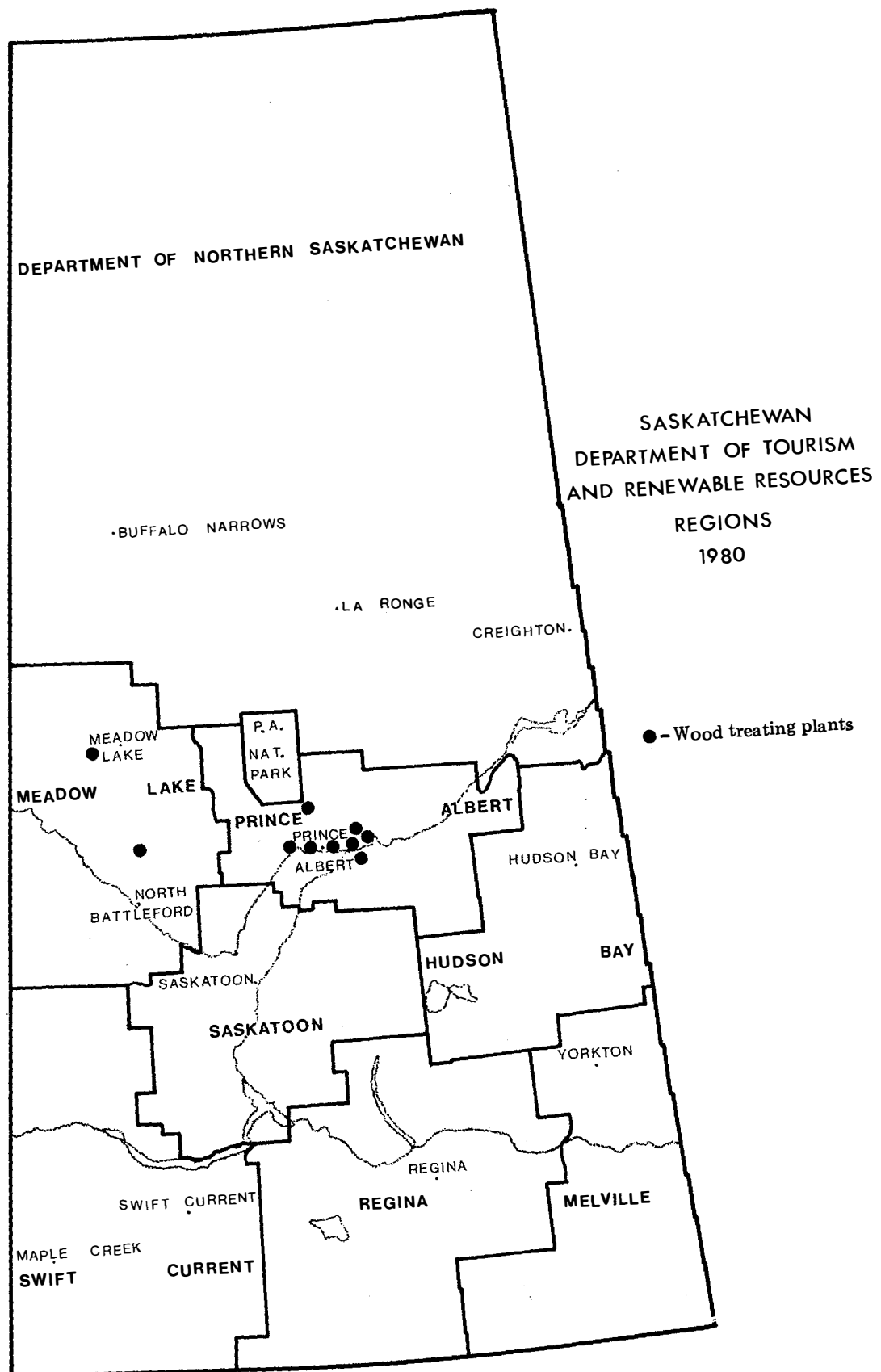


Figure 6. Location of wood treating plants producing more than 100 M cubic feet.

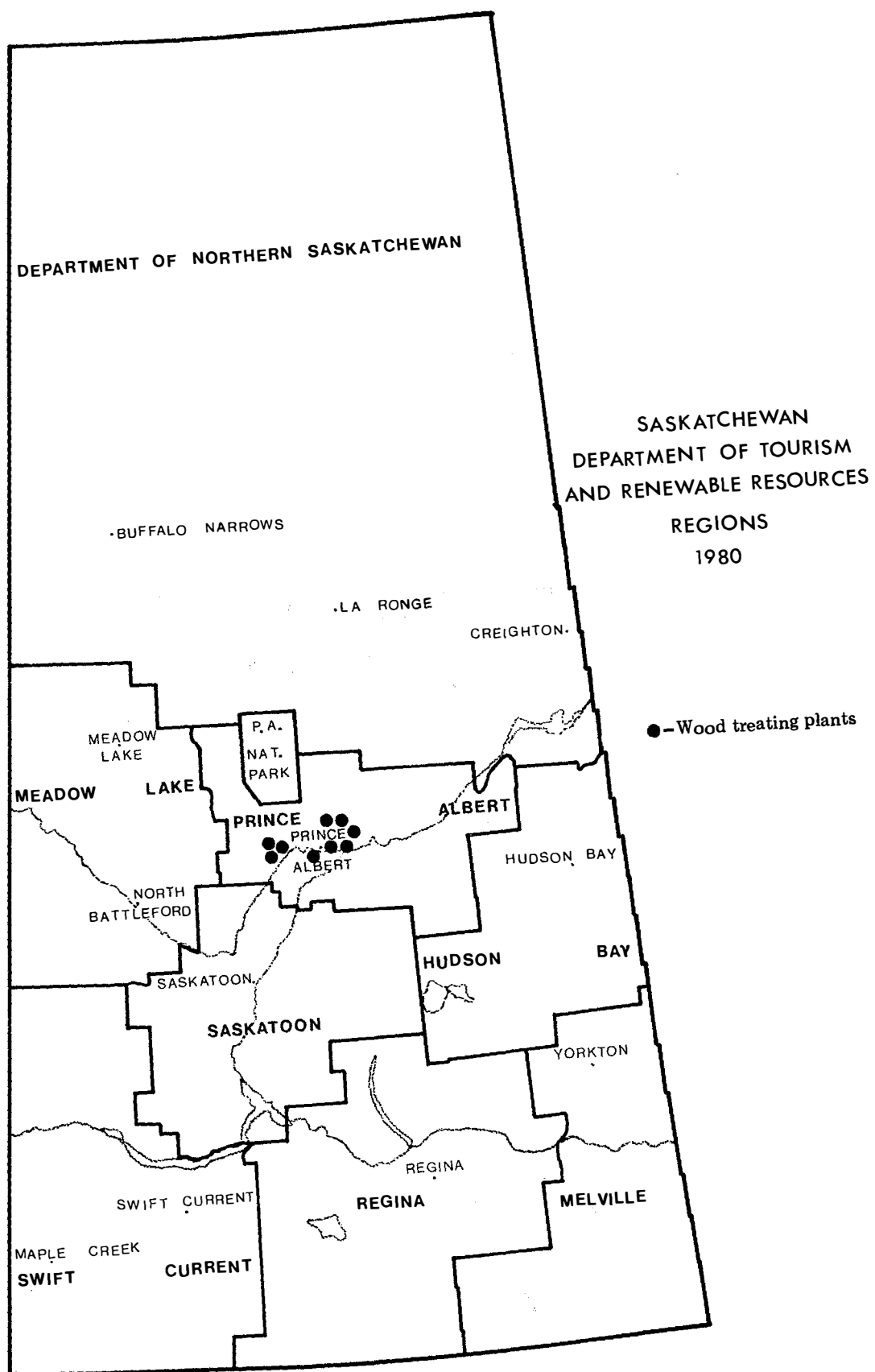


Figure 7. Location of wood treating plants producing less than 100 M cubic feet.

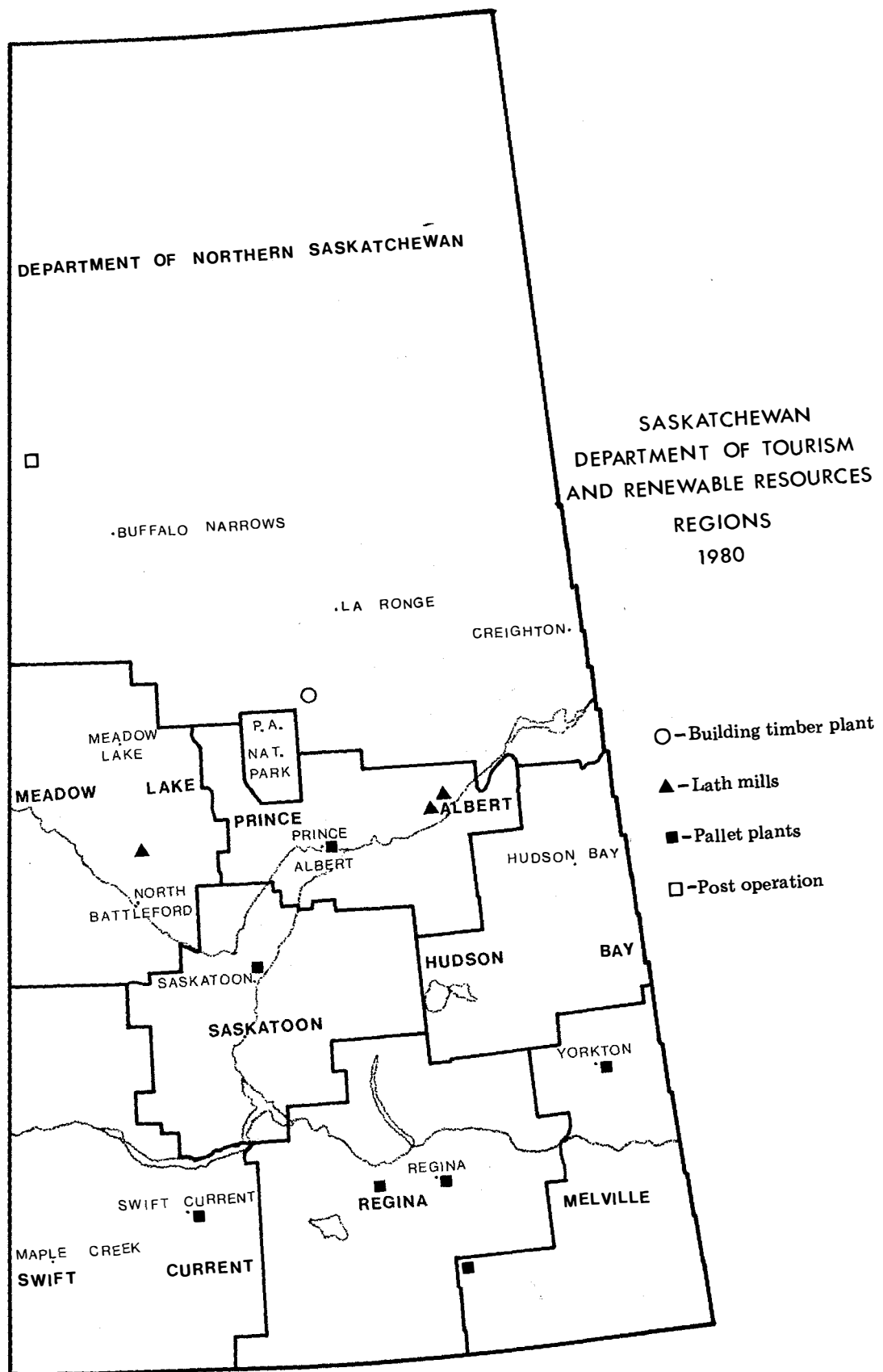


Figure 8. Location of miscellaneous wood-using industries.

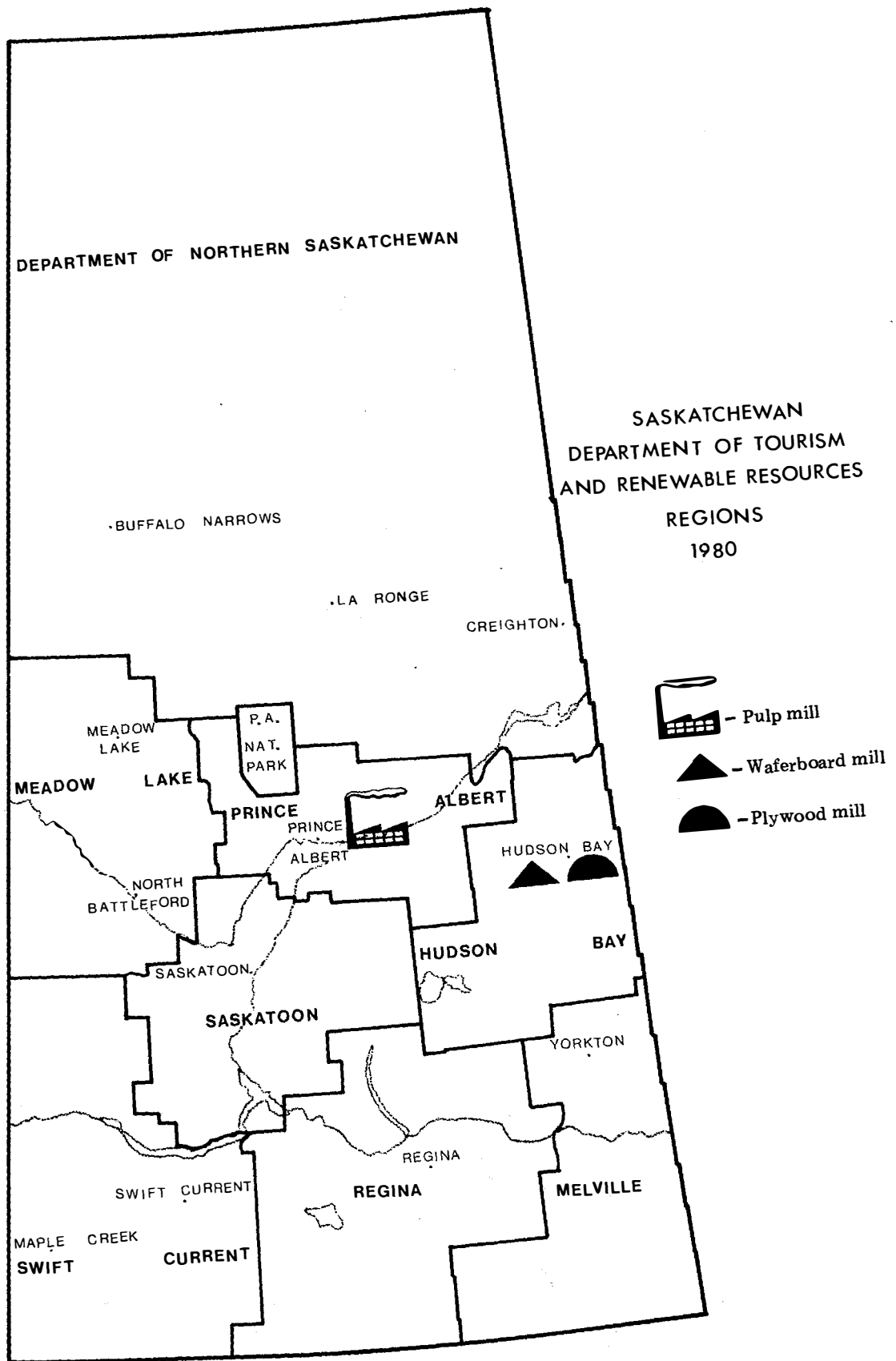


Figure 9. Location of pulp, waferboard, and plywood mills.
