TERMINATION OF FOREST INSECT AND DISEASE NOTES

The Forest Insect and Disease Notes have been published three times per year since December 1987 by staff of the former Forest Insect and Disease Management Systems and Surveys. Between December 1987 and 1989, the notes were published as part of the Technology Transfer Note series and thereafter as a standalone series. The Forest Insect and Disease Notes have focussed on providing summaries of major insect and disease conditions throughout west-central Canada, short papers on insect and disease research at our centre, and changes to

programs and staff. The December 1996 issue will be the last in the series due to program changes and reorganization of the CFS.

It is anticipated that a new national newsletter will be produced by the Forest Health Network, one of ten Science and Technology Networks within the CFS. The newsletter will focus on the complex issues related to the health of Canadian forests as well as research activities within the network. Recipients of the *Forest Insect and Disease Notes* will be placed on the mailing list of the national Forest Health Network newsletter.
