EUROPEAN PINE SHOOT MOTH SURVEY OF PLANTATIONS

IN THE OKANAGAN VALLEY, MAY, 1974

No shoot moths or signs of their damage were noted in Okanagan Valley pine plantations in 1974. Late in May, 844 Scots pines were examined in five plantations for the presence of the European pine shoot moth, *Rhyacionia buoliana*. Naturally-seeded lodgepole and ponderosa pines were also checked when they occurred in or around the Scots pine plantations. The following table lists the location and number of pine species examined.
