FOREST INSECT SURVEY

## INTRODUCTION

The number of insect collections made in 1953 totalled 6,386 compared with 6,685 during 1952. The Victoria Laboratory received 3,014 collections from the coastal forests of British Columbia, and the Vernon sub-laboratory handled 3,372 from the interior forests east of the Coast Mountains. The survey of insect diseases was continued in 1953. Over 600 specimens involving 21 insect species were submitted for examination and diagnosis. The incidence of disease in the important insects of the Province was low, but there was a significant amount of virus and fungous disease in Malacosoma disstria Hbn. and Malacosoma pluviale (Dyar) collections.

The motor-vessel "J. M. Swaine" was replaced by a smaller, faster boat in 1953. The new vessel was used throughout the season in the southern waters around Vancouver Island, the Johnston Strait Islands, and along the mainland from Vancouver north to Ocean Falls.
