INTRODUCTION

The Forest Insect and Disease Survey maintains a comprehensive insect reference collection to assist in determining the distribution and seasonal occurrence of the more common insects in the region. The collection contains primarily adult specimens but immature forms and photographs of specimens are added as they become available.

In 1968 the Newfoundland Forest Research Centre published a checklist of forest insect specimens collected in Newfoundland by the Forest Insect and Disease Survey and maintained in the Research Centre Museum at St. John's (Pardy et al. 1968). At that time the list included a total of 366 insect species. In 1974 the checklist was revised (Pardy 1974) and included a total of 907 species. However, many of the new additions had not been collected in Newfoundland, but were introduced species or ones that had been obtained from other regions in Canada or from other countries. Since 1974 many additional specimens, mostly from Newfoundland and Labrador, have been added to the collection and this list now includes a total of 1,101 species of which 699 have been collected from the Island or Labrador.

The order, families and scientific names in this list have been listed according to the "Forest Insect Numerical Code" developed by the Forest Insect and Disease Survey. The majority of the common names are on the approved list of common names for North America published by the Entomological Society of America (Anderson, 1975); these names are underlined in this checklist. The other common names have been taken from Benoit 1975, Borror and Delong 1964, and Miller and Lindquist 1971.

In the checklist the geographic origin of the species is included and if photographs of the insects or damage they cause are in the files, they are shown by symbols, i.e. (B & W) for black and white prints or (C) for 35 mm color transparencies. Where the origin of the species is not shown Newfoundland and Labrador is the source of the collection.

The adult specimens in the museum collection are usually pinned and labelled, housed in glass-topped trays and stored in metal cabinets. Some adult specimens are preserved in 70% alcohol and stored in glass vials. However, many of the immature stages are not stored in liquid preservatives but are preserved by other procedures such as freeze drying which retains the natural colors of the specimens and results in only little or no shrinkage or distortion. Such specimens are also stored in glass-topped trays in metal cabinets.

The majority of the museum specimens have been identified by specialists at the Biosystematic Research Institute, Ottawa, and the others by entomologists at the Newfoundland Forest Research Centre, St. John's.

The major purpose of the insect museum is for the use of Research Centre and visiting entomologists as an up-to-date reference collection but it is also a valuable aid for the preparation of display cases of the more common and important Newfoundland insects for use in the National Parks, Provincial Parks, schools and other interested agencies or associations. Many of these have already been prepared and distributed and two major revised ones are now in preparation for Terra Nova and Gros Morne National Parks.
